### Air Rifle, Air Pistol, Free, Standard and Center Fire/Sport Pistol

**Match Dates:**

**Times:** **9:00 am:** Two relays of 10M Air Pistol and Air Rifle relays, starting at 9 AM and second relay at approximately 10:30 am to 11:00 am. 10 shooters max per relay.

**1:00 pm Approx:** One Relay each: Free Pistol, Standard Pistol and Center Fire or Sport Pistol at 50 feet. 10 shooters max per relay.

**Location:** HHRPC Indoor Range, Columbus, IN. See [www.hhrp.org](http://www.hhrp.org) for directions.

**Competition:** These matches are NRA Approved Open Tournaments and USA Shooting Sanctioned Competitions. Competitors will be classified per the NRA and USAS Classification Systems. Scores will reported to NRA, USAS, or both, for record and classification purposes.

**Rules:** NRA and USA Shooting International Rules apply.

**Safety:** All competitors must wear safety glasses.

**Entries:** **Advance entries are required and confirmation will be provided by e-mail.** Those shooters attending without advance entry may participate only if the relays are not fully subscribed. Juniors and women shooters are encouraged and welcome. Loaner air guns are available for new shooters.

**Matches:**

**Air Rifle:** AR-5/10 target. 20 min per target including sighting shots 1 record shot/bull. Time limit for 60 shot course plus sighting shots is 2 hours. The time limit for juniors and women, shooting a 40 shot course plus sighting shots, is 80 min. Two (2) shots per bull will be allowed for less skilled competitors.

**Air Pistol:** B-40/4 target. 1 hour 45 minutes for 60 record shots, 5 shots per bull, 20 shots per target plus sighting target. Juniors and women may shoot 40 record shots plus sighting target in max of 1 hour 15 min.

**Free Pistol:** B-11 target. 2 hours for 60 record shots plus unlimited sighting shots. 10 record shots per target. Any .22 caliber pistol or revolver that may be loaded one round at a time may be used.

**Std. Pistol:** B33 target. 60 record shots, 20 shots each slow, timed and rapid fire. Slow fire 150 sec.; timed fire 20 sec; and rapid fire 10 sec for each 5 shot series, 10 shots per target. Any semi-auto .22 caliber pistol may be used.

**Center Fire and Sport Pistol:** B33 target: 30 shots Precision Course, 5 shot series in 5 minutes per series, 10 shots per target. B39 Target: 30 shots Rapid Fire Course, 5 shot series in 10-second intervals, 3 seconds per shot, 10 shots per target. Targets will be fixed, verbal commands and sounds shall be used. Center fire is any 30-caliber pistol, .32-.380 inches. Sport Pistol is .22 caliber and open to all women and junior men.

**Match fees:** **NRA Competitors:** \$12.00 for first match, \$8.00 for each additional match. Juniors \$6.00 per match. (\$4.50 of each match goes to the NRA.)

**USA Shooting Competitors:** \$12.00 for first match, \$5.00 for each additional match. Juniors \$8.00 for first match, \$5.00 for each additional match. (\$5.00 of the first match and \$2.00 for subsequent matches goes to USA Shooting.) Match scores also reported to the NRA for: \$5.00 surcharge per match.

Fees are due upon arrival at the range.

**Awards:** **Ribbons Awards** will be awarded for the first three places in each match by classification.

**Facilities:** *Please note that potable water is not available at the shooting range and the lavatory facilities are outside and temporary. Shooters wishing to have a light meal at a local establishment should arrange their time to eat between the Air Gun matches and the Free Pistol match. Otherwise, it is suggested that you bring something to eat if also shooting in the afternoon matches.*
