

Introduction to Basic Handgun

A Hoosier Hills Rifle and Pistol Club Educational Program

The objective of this educational program is to educate the public who own, or plan to own, a handgun about:

- Responsibility of handgun ownership.
- How to be safe and use their handgun safely.
- How their handgun functions, its' operation and maintenance.
- The fundamentals of shooting and hitting an intended target.
- How to purchase a handgun suitable for the student's objectives.

The educational program is a four-hour duration class followed by range time to allow participants to shoot a handgun at a paper target.

The cost is \$40. Students must register in advance and each class is limited to 8 persons. The class is held at the Hoosier Hills Rifle and Pistol Club's Indoor range located near the Columbus Airport.

The classes are held on a Saturday morning starting promptly at 8AM. Dates are announced and posted on the club web site Schedule – HHPR.org.

Students should bring their own handgun and one box of ammunition. If they do not currently own a handgun a suitable handgun and ammunition will be provided.

The Hoosier Hills Rifle and Pistol Club's Basic Handgun class is taught by an experienced NRA Certified Rifle and Pistol Instructor, Chief Range Safety Officer and Pistol Coach. This class is not NRA approved training.
